servants. In fact

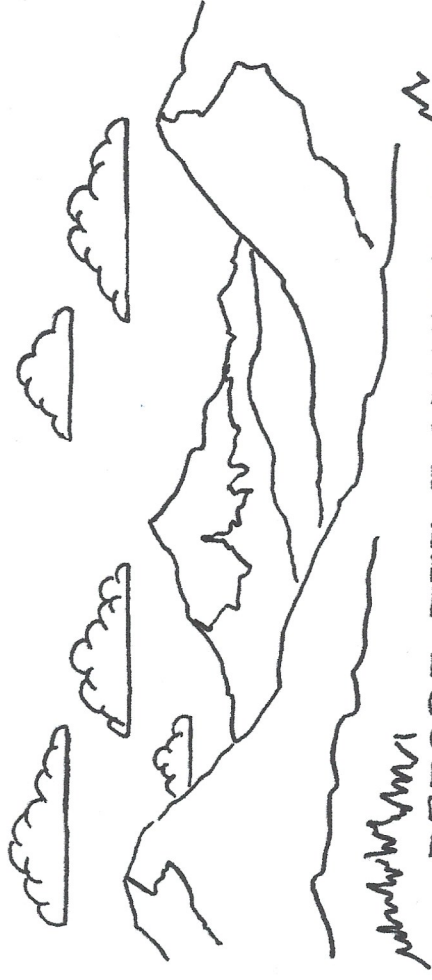
God shows amazing grace to

of God's family for ever and we can be part of

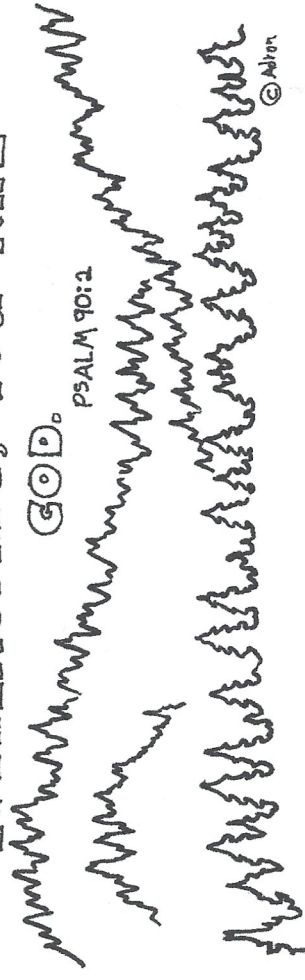
God's work that will last forever.
