

Today we're going to learn three things about

Jesus the King.

Firstly: Jesus the King came to

serve.

We see this in the way Jesus went into Jerusalem. He chose to ride on a

donkey. He didn't

usually ride on a donkey so he wanted us to

learn something about him.

He wanted us to see that he is not a King like

the Gentile kings who ride in

chariots. God's King

is victorious but humble.

Second: Jesus the King came to

warn. What Jesus did in the

temple warns us that we can't just turn up at

church on Sunday and then

live as if God isn't there the rest of the week.
To help us understand this more we need to
see the third thing in our passage: Jesus the

King came to **destroy**.

Jesus destroys a fig **tree**

because it doesn't have any fruit like it should
He wants us to see that


the **temple** is like the tree
