

Our passage today carries on from last week.

Jesus is still **talking** about

the **problem** with
the Pharisees: That they are

acting like they are God's

people but really they are not inside. That's
what the word

'hypocrite'

means that comes up a lot in this passage!

Jesus talks about 7 problems or

'woes' that the Pharisees

have:

- Woe 1 - You **stop** people

entering God's Kingdom

- Woe 2 - You lead people to

hell

- Woe 3 - Things of earth are more
important to you than things of

God

- Woe 4 - You love little

rules but you don't love the things God cares about

- Woes 5 & 6 - You try to

look Godly, but inside you

are not.

- Woe 7 - You are horrible to those who


speak God's word

We see that this all makes Jesus very

sad.

But he will judge these wrongs.

Although this passage is a lot about Jesus's judgement, we also see how he loves his people and longs for even those who turn away to repent and come back to him. Jesus described this as being like a mother hen gathering her chicks under her wings. Colour the picture to remind you of this.
