Firstly we see that the

**disciples** want to

obey Jesus but can't.

Jesus tells them that they will all

**leave** him, even though they  
say that they will not.

And we are the **same** too,  
because that is what sinful humans are all

like. We are **weak** and tend  
to turn away from God which is why we need

**Jesus** to die for us.

Secondly in our passage today we see that

Jesus didn't want to die but  
must/will.

Jesus is very,

very sad that he has to die, he

felt the same way we would feel. But he is

different from us

in that he will do it. He will

obey his Father God.

Pray with your grown-up thanking Jesus very much that he obeyed his Father God by dying in our place so we don't have to face God's anger if we trust in Jesus' death. Colour the picture of Jesus praying in the garden while his disciples fell asleep.
