Like those people, we're to pray for

not cake, this helps us remember to ask God for what we need not be greedy.

2. This isn't just a prayer for me! Give

us!

God gives stuff to me, for me and you. We pray for God to provide for others too.

3. Jesus is the bread of life.

God gives us what we need now but also what we need for
