We see in the passage **three**

ways God's people might sin unintentionally against Him and need to pay Him back for this:

1. Sinning against the **holy**

things of God.

2. Going against God's

commandments

3. Financial Sins (that's to do with

money)

Next we see four things that matter to God in this passage:

1. Holy things matter

Back then this was the things in the tabernacle, now it is the church and our bodies.

2. God's honour matters

When we lie and steal God is dishonoured.

3. Repayment matters

Being forgiven

doesn't mean we

just forget about what we have done. We need to make it right with the person we have done wrong to.

4. Repentance matters

It is right to confess our sins to God.

and how Jesus is our great
