


Sin made God's house dirty. God's house was called the Tabernacle. Colour in the picture of the Tabernacle below.



Today we are in Leviticus looking at some more of the **laws** God gave His people.

Remember from last week, these laws taught God's people about **holiness**.

They taught God's people how to be **clean** from sin so they could come near to Him.

The law was a burden and grace
The law of Moses was good. It was

holy and righteous (that means it was **right** in every way!

But... the law was also very **hard** for
God's people to live under.

God uses the law to show us our **sin**.
And to show what Jesus has done for us.

God wants to bring new life
God made laws about things a man's body does
and things a woman's body does.

These laws were a reminder that we live in a
broken world where our bodies
don't always work properly!

This reminded God's people that we are
fallen and we need God to make
us clean and whole.

Where is the **Gospel** in this
passage?

Sin made God's house **dirty**.
Sin put God's people in danger of God leaving
them!

That is why we need **Jesus**. Jesus
came into this broken and dirty world to make
us clean so that we could come in God's
presence and live as God's
people.
