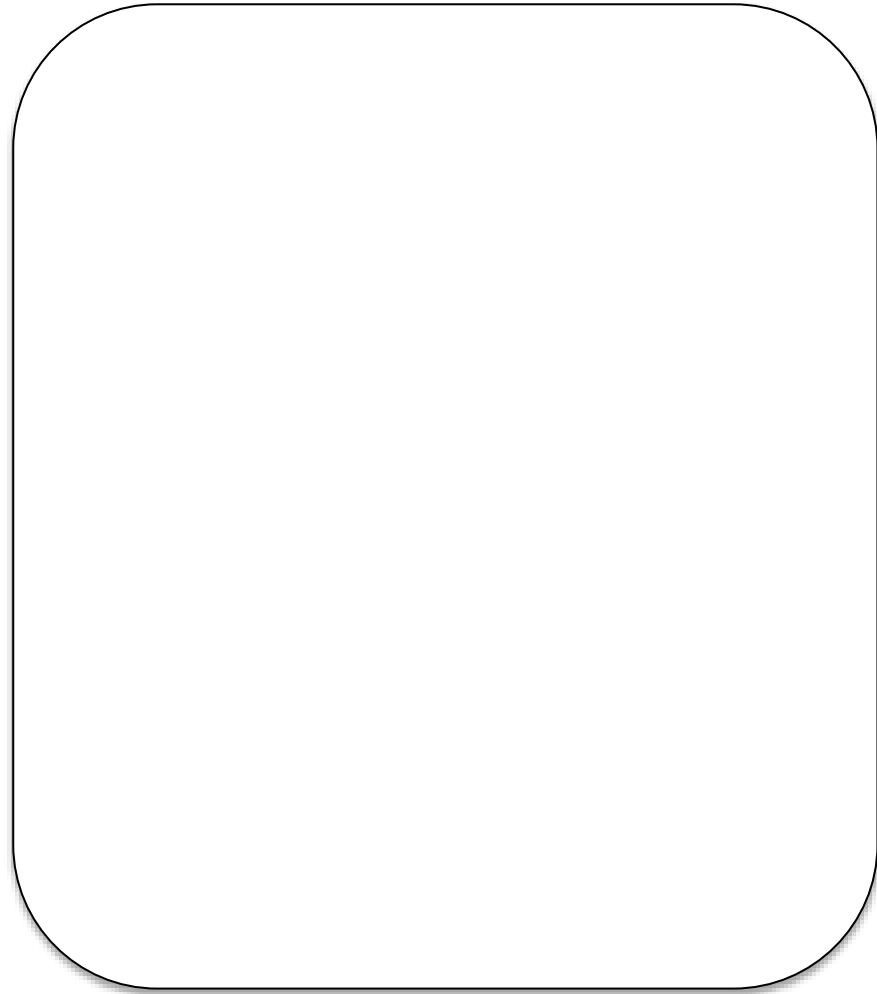


God commands us to love Him and love other people. Draw a picture to show how you can love other people. You could help a friend when they are hurt. How else can you love other people?



Today we are in Leviticus chapters 17-22.

The story of Leviticus so far...

God has **rescued** His people
from slavery and the tabernacle (God's house)
has been built.

God has told His people how to be **clean**
so they can worship Him. Now God is going to
teach His people what **holiness**
looks like.

Holiness is to be shared with God's people

God is holy and He wants His people to be

holy too.

He promises to walk with us and sanctify us (that means He makes us holy so we can become more like him).

Christians have

the **Holy Spirit** living in us.

He helps us be like God so we can know Him better.

What does holiness look like?

God's people must **love** God and love people.

We must be **different** to those around us who don't obey God.

God doesn't leave us to do this alone. He has given us the Holy Spirit to **help** us.

God opposes the unholy

God takes holiness and sin very

seriously and the **bible** teaches us that God will judge sin.

For Christians, Jesus

forgives us and cleans us of our sin and the Holy Spirit works in us to make us holy so that we can grow closer to God.
