Sunday.

Appointed Feasts:

There were seven of these each
year. All of them helped the people to rest

and to remember and
worship together.

What happened when the people
met together in these ways? The Lord

tabernacle, the light shining on the
bread, to help us see what
Jesus does as he invites us to come into his
light, out of the darkness.
