


Jesus told the man He had rescued to go tell everyone about it! Can you help him find his way through the maze to tell his

What Jesus does for us

In this true story, Jesus steps out of the boat and sees a man who is possessed by **demons**.

This man lived alone, among the tombs, he cried out, and hurt himself. He needed **help**.

No one had been able to help him. But now...  
*Who do you think was going to help this man?*

Satan's power... and Jesus' great power

When this man saw **Jesus**, he ran towards Him and fell down in front of Him!

Everyone was **afraid** of the demons  
but the demons were afraid of Jesus! They  
knew exactly who He was... the Son of the  
Most High **God**.

Jesus cast out the demons. Finally, the  
demon-possessed man was free, sitting quietly  
because Jesus had **rescued** Him.

We all need to be rescued like this man.  
Jesus rescues us by His death on  
the **CROSS**.

What do we do with Jesus?

When people saw the demon-possessed man  
was well, they were so afraid, they begged  
Jesus to **leave**.

They saw how **powerful** Jesus was  
when He did what no one else could do.

But... the man Jesus had healed begged Him  
to let him **stay** with Him. Jesus told  
him to **tell** everyone how He had  
rescued him.

We have the same job today. If we belong to  
Jesus, the Bible tells us to tell everyone how  
He has rescued us. We have nothing to be  
afraid of when we belong to Jesus.
