1. They are

people who aren't God's people.

2. They are breaking the

special

agreement (covenant) with their wives.

3. They are carrying on doing

'religious

stuff'

but they

don't understand why God is

not

pleased with what they are
doing.

So what does this mean for us?

Firstly, we need to understand that marrying a non-Christian is

risky.

Secondly, we need to understand that

divorce is painful.

Thirdly we need to make sure we are not covenant

breakers.

But we also need to be encouraged that

God is faithful

even when we are not.
